The need for books in Nigeria is critical....

In Nigeria there is a tremendous shortage of educational materials, and those materials that are available are out of date.

EON wants to help..

Education Opportunities for Nigeria, Inc. is a non-profit organization in the United States, dedicated to assisting Nigerian schools and Universities by shipping used text books and other educational materials to them. EON would like to reach local levels in all of the Nigerian States where there is a critical shortage of educational supplies.

Since its formation in October 1993, EON had made four major shipments to Nigeria. The first two shipments (20' X 8' X 8.5') were given to the Nigeria University Commission who distributed them among federal Government institutions in Nigeria.

These shipments included fifty computers and about 40,000 high school and college level textbooks to be distributed among the Federal institutions in the nation, as well as medical textbooks at an estimated market value of \$120,000.00 per shipment. Two shipments (20' X 8' X 8.5') also went to Akwa Ibom State.

A Cooperative effort....

This operation is a cooperative effort with volunteers' help in the labor-intensive work of loading the books. Books have been donated from many different individuals and organizations. For the first shipments EON enjoyed the support of the Nigeria Education attaché in the United States, who took care of the shipping arrangements and the distribution of the books to the Federal Ministry of Education in Nigeria.

Many Sorts of donors..

The books have been donated by the School Board of Alachua County in Gainesville Florida, the University of Florida Medical library & Library West, Florida Bookstore, Goering bookstore, International Book Project Inc. in Lexington Kentucky, Gator Textbook Inc, University of Florida faculties, Santa Fe Community College and Students. EON just needs to collect the books and arrange the shipping.

How can you help?

The cost of storage and shipping is our biggest expense. Apostle George Brantley of The Rock of Gainesville, Florida donated a storage Container and

The Volyes family of Gainesville provided a space for the container. Books, computers have been coming in from donors. The 40' X 8' X 7.5' is almost full. Our team is raising \$10,000.00 to cover the shipping, distribution with our representatives. Financial donations to meet these expenses are our greatest need. We thank you for any assistance you can provide for us.

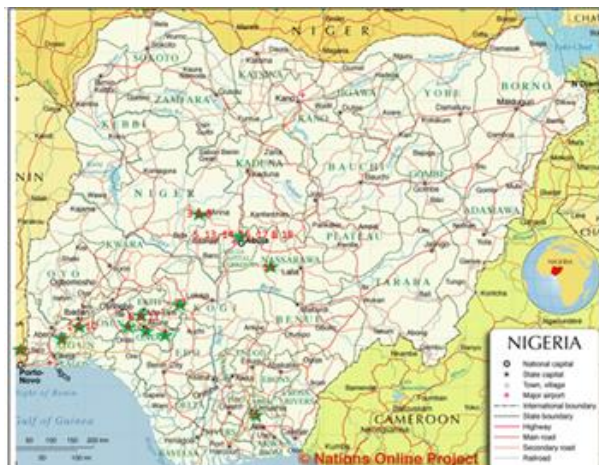
Teachers frustrated for lack of materials to work with...
